Criteria for the Wauzhushk Onigum Legacy Education Fund

1. Candidates must be focused on continuing their education at a College, University, or Trade program.
2. Candidates must have applied to the Wauzhushk Onigum Nation Post Secondary program offered by the Biindigen Learning Centre, and;
 - a. Been partially accepted for funding and are seeking funds not being covered by the program, or
 - b. Been provided a denial letter based the following criteria (please see the 2020/21 WON Post Secondary Student Programs – Administrative Guidelines and Procedures manual) not being met,
 - i. Must be a registered status member of Wauzhushk Onigum Nation.
 - ii. Must be listed with Wauzhushk Onigum Nation in accordance with the Indian Registry Program as officially declared by Aboriginal Affairs and Northern Development Canada and/or officially acknowledged by Wauzhushk Onigum Nation. Provision of legal custody documents may be required for verification of child support benefits if claiming dependents.
 - iii. Must be enrolled in or be accepted for enrolment in a post-secondary institution. Must provide a Letter of Acceptance from the respective university or college.
 - iv. Must complete two applications to bursary/scholarship funds. Funding will not be affected upon outcome of said bursary/scholarship application.
3. Candidates that have been denied by the Wauzhushk Onigum Nation Post Secondary program must apply and be denied (in writing) by two alternative funding bodies (i.e. NeChee Friendship Centre, Shooniyaa Wa Biitong,etc)
4. **Deadline Dates:**

August 15 for programs commencing between September - December

December 15 for programs commencing between January - April

April 15 for programs commencing between May - August
